MEREDITH, WILLIAM, Capt.
William Meredith, of Welsh descent and a native of Louisa County, Virginia,

early migrated to the Yadkin country, where he became a neighbor of Col. Cleveland. He was appointed an ensign in 1776 and took an active part in the war. Meredith was a company commander under Cleveland at Kings Mountain and was in the battle at Cowpens. After the war he was a school teacher.
